For the period 24 April 2014 – 23 October 2014 non-compliant buses were used on the following days:


28 June 2014	AFL Launceston
29 September 2014	First day school holidays
14 June 2014	Dark MOFO Hobart
21 June 2014	Dark MOFO Hobart

Non-compliant buses were used due to additional passengers travelling to events in Hobart and Launceston or high loadings in the case of the first day of school holidays.

One non-compliant bus was used on each occasion and a compliant bus was also used on the same service.
