As a young (when I started) woman who has worked in politics for over ten years in senior roles - I have only ever been treated inappropriately by an attitude to women in the workplace that I have only otherwise read about existing decades ago. On multiple occasions when I have been negotiating with a prearance or suggested an activity outside of work; which has made me feel sexualised and insecure. I have never been treated inappropriately by ; each has acted with professionalism.
I say this because Parliament House does not have one culture; it has many.
I do not make this submission with partisan intention, but it would be a mistake to ignore that political ideology impacts cultures.
