of the criminal justice system for people with disability who need communication supports or who have complex and multiple support needs.

You don't have to answer all these questions if they are not relevant to you.

Questions

1. What are the biggest barriers for you or other people with disability in the criminal justice system?

Lack of understanding of consequences for the person with a disability, organisations passing the buck and not wanting to take responsibility.

2. What could be done to remove these barriers and help people with disability in the criminal justice system?

Disability and criminal organisations need to work together to support the person with a disability.

3. Can you provide information about support that has helped you or other people with disability to participate in the criminal justice system?

The police knowing that the person with a disability being known to have case management support.

4. Please tell us about any time that you or another person with disability

experienced barriers to justice.

Person with a disability being charged with a violent assault and having know suitable lock up facilities to suit their needs.

5. Do you have any other thoughts, ideas or comments you would like to make about people with disability and the criminal justice system? It is the responsibility of all organisations to work together to provide the best possible outcome for the person with a disability. I feel more education, awareness and recognition for the person with a disability. Suitable facilities, specialising in disabilities not main stream incarceration.
